

Family/Living Room

The Family Room is often the largest room in the house and requires the greatest furniture investment. Your investment will vary based on the size of the room and functions.

We recommend that you invest in the rug and upholstery first, as foundation pieces, and to set the scale and style of the room.

Dining Room

The Dining Room's largest investments are your table and chairs. A statement lighting fixture or rug will add to that impact.

The investment will depend on the size of the room, how many people you want to seat. The details here are based on a table with seating for eight.

Primary Bedroom

The Bedroom's largest investment is the bed frame, headboard, and mattress. You'll need night chests, a dresser or other case piece below a mirror, artwork, or flatscreen TV and drapery for privacy and light control.

A bench at the foot of the bed is convenient and a chair with an ottoman for reading with good light and a table is another welcome option.


